Darda Sales, Paralympic Swimmer

At age nine, Darda met three athletes at her first swim meet who were training for the Paralympics Games in Barcelona and they inspired her. Darda has been representing Canada internationally for the past 8 years as a member of the National Swimmers with a Disability Swim Team.

Today, Darda is a three-time Paralympian. Her accomplishments include being a member of the gold medal winning, world record breaking 4x100 medley relay team at the 2000 Paralympics in Sydney, Australia and she won a silver medal in the same event at the 2004 Paralympic Games in Athens, Greece. Darda was a two time bronze medalist at the IPC World Championships in 2006 and a two time gold medalist at the Para Pan American Games in 2007.
